(b) Propositions concerning humans

[1] Humans are spirits in union with bodies

Human beings are persons who have both a spiritual and a physical nature. They are personal beings with God-consciousness, having been created in the image of God. Their personalities survive death, and the dissolution of their physical nature, in a disembodied state.

Jas 2:26 For just as the body without (the) spirit is dead, so also faith without works is dead.

2 Cor 5:6-8 Therefore, being always of good courage, and knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord -- for we walk by faith, not by sight -- we are of good courage, I say, and prefer rather to be absent from the body and to be at home with the Lord.

[2] Humans are finite

Human beings are limited in relation to time and space, and in knowledge and power.

Jas 4:13-14 Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow, we shall go to such and such a city, and spend a year there and engage in business and make a profit." Yet you do not know what your life will be like tomorrow. You are (just) a vapor that appears for a little while and then vanishes away.

Prov 27:1 Do not boast about tomorrow, For you do not know what a day may bring forth.
