(c) Propostions concerning nonpersonal beings (both animate and inanimate)

[1] Nonpersonal beings are material and nonpersonal; some are also animate

1 Cor 15:39-41 All flesh is not the same flesh, but there is one {flesh} of men, and another flesh of beasts, and another flesh of birds, and another of fish. There are also heavenly bodies and earthly bodies, but the glory of the heavenly is one, and the {glory} of the earthly is another. There is one glory of the sun, and another glory of the moon, and another glory of the stars; for star differs from star in glory.
