4. How can miracles be possible?

Is the universe a closed system of cause and effect?
-- problem of evidence for closedness, on both
small and large size-scales

-- problem of philosophical arguments against miraculous

Analogy between miracles and actions produced by human minds No insuperable problem either philosophically or theoretically for miracles

Question is: what evidence do we have for a particular miracle?

5. Isn't faith blind and irrational and a psychological crutch?

Some faith <u>is</u> blind and irrational: -- blind when you don't know who/what you are trusting -- irrational when you do but object is unworthy of trust Probably all faith is a psychological crutch: dependence on something beyond selves for strength real Q is: -- do we need a crutch? -- will <u>this</u> crutch hold us up when we really need it?

6. Isn't being good good enough?

Yes, if you're good enough! Ten commandments: Jesus explains them in Sermon on Mt Two commandments: -- Love God with all your heart/soul/mind -- Love your neighbor as yourself Only Jesus was good enough Only Jesus is the kind of being who can transfer to us His

7. Isn't it arrogant to say that Jesus is the only way to God? What about sincere people in other religions?

righteousness, take our sins upon himself

This <u>is</u> what the Bible teaches John 14:6: I am the way/truth/life... Acts 4:12: salvation in no one else... None of us are totally sincere (Relative) sincerity is not good enough Prov 14:12: way that <u>seems</u> right... end is death Explain person and work of Jesus Christ
