if 1000 men in firing squad hadn't missed me...

Strong Anthropic Principle - J.D. Barrow future events cause past ones

but self-contradictory

time-machine paradox: imagine you have a time-machine then buy gold brick, multiply it by going back in time and picking it up and putting in machine again and again

Many Worlds Hypothesis - Hugh Everett

at each moment, universe branching into many universes we are in one of few allowing life

but no evidence for such branching

Oscillating Universe Hypothesis - John Wheeler many worlds in succession rather than simultaneously

but problems of bounce & infinite repetition
(recall our discussion under "Origin of Universe")

CONCLUSIONS

- All of these make rather strong assumptions regarding the nature of unseen reality without positive evidence; Christianity presents corroborating evidence for its worldview in historical evidence of God's intervention, fulfilled prophecy, changed lives
- A creation model would expect that design of this sort would be present, but it is a great fluke in worldviews which have no mind behind the universe

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
