

In Romans 1:16-17 "faith" is used more specifically to mean "trust in Christ and His saving work as revealed in the gospel."

Putting together the ideas of these four terms as they are used in Romans 1:16-17, we must now ask more specifically: what is the gospel?

THE GOSPEL IS THE GOOD NEWS
OF DELIVERANCE FROM SIN
THROUGH THE REVELATION OF GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS
TO EVERYONE WHO TRUSTS IN JESUS CHRIST

And now we can define "salvation" more precisely.

Overhead

SALVATION IS DELIVERANCE FROM SIN
AND ITS CONSEQUENCES
TO GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS
AND ITS BENEFITS

But now we must ask the second major question of this week's study:

II. WHO NEEDS TO BE SAVED, AND WHY?
