WEEK 11

What godlike qualities do we need to add to our faith and develop in our character and conduct?

This is the eleventh lesson of this series on salvation. In lesson 10 we began by noting that sanctification in the subjective, experiential sense is really all about growing toward spiritual maturity. We then turned to 2 Peter 1:1-11 and looked at seven foundational gifts that God has given us to enable us to grow toward spiritual maturity:

- a. God has chosen us to salvation by His marvelous grace
- God has given us His dear Son to earn righteousness for us by His atoning work
- c. God has called us to Himself by His Spirit and Word in the gospel
- d. God has given us the gift of saving faith in Christ
- e. God has given us the privilege of knowing Him personally
- f. God has cleansed us from our sins through the blood of Christ
- g. God has given us very great and precious promises in His Word

We also noted that Peter says we need to exert ourselves to move forward in sanctification. In order to do this, we saw that we need to lay hold of God's promises with active faith, and we need to add and develop godlike qualities in our character and conduct.

In this eleventh lesson we need to ask and attempt to answer one question:

WHAT GODLIKE QUALITIES DO WE NEED TO ADD TO OUR FAITH AND DEVELOP IN OUR CHARACTER AND CONDUCT?
