

C. Who has the attitude or spirit of Secular Humanism?

Human beings that have the basic attitude or spirit of Secular Humanism include:

Those who try to cut themselves off from God

Those who refuse to recognize who and what God is, what the world is, and who and what they are

Those who refuse to acknowledge their total dependence upon God, and their obligations to give Him the gratitude, worship, and obedience due Him

Those who refuse to think God's revealed thoughts after Him

Those who reject God's revealed values and standards for man

Those who make human reason the final standard of judgment as to the answers to the most basic issues and questions of life, and thus make themselves gods

This is the essential attitude or spirit of Secular Humanism; and to some extent it characterizes all non-Christians.
