This leaves us with 22 references yet to be classified. Of these 22, 8 predict the ultimate salvation of Israel by the pouring out upon them of the Holy Spirit. These references include:

(It should be noted that, of these 8 scriptures, Haggai 2:5 appears to have some reference to Haggai's day, as well as to the promised future)

Of the 14 remaining references, 4 indicate the idea of physical strength given by the Holy Spirit to an individual. They all refer to one man, Samson, and include Judges 13:25, 14:6, 14:19, and 15:14. There are 3 scriptures which speak of special abilities or skills conferred upon the individual; and these include Genesis 41:38, Exodus 31:3, and Exodus 35:31. And there are 4 scriptures which may be classified as miscellaneous: Genesis 6:3, which appears to speak of God's common grace in the Spirit's restraining and convicting ministry in the ante-diluvian period; I Kings 18:12 and II Kings 2:16, which suggests the idea of the possibility of the physical transportation, by the Spirit, of Elijah to another location; and Psalm 139:7, which emphasizes the omnipresence of the Spirit of God.
