

(c) Of the nine scriptures referred to (Isaiah 32:15, 44:3, 59:21; Ezekiel 36:27, 37:14, 39:29; Joel 2:28; Haggai 2:5; and Zechariah 12:10), the terms employed to express the Holy Spirit's action or relationship include five cases of "pouring upon," one case of "putting within," one case of "putting in," one case of "not departing from," and one case of "remaining among."

(d) Of the nine above mentioned scriptures, the effects resulting from the Holy Spirit's action or relationship as learned from the contents and contexts of these scriptures is as follows:

Isaiah 32:15

The context is as follows: (32:10, 13-18)

"Many days and years shall ye be troubled, ye careless women; for the vintage shall fail, the gathering shall not come. Upon the land of my people shall come up thorns and briars; yea, upon all the houses of joy in the joyous city. Because the palaces shall be forsaken; the multitude of the city shall be left; the forts and towers shall be for dens for ever, a joy of wild asses, a pasture of flocks. Until the Spirit be poured upon us from on high, and the wilderness be a fruitful field, and the fruitful field be counted for a forest. Then judgment shall dwell in the wilderness, and righteousness remain in the fruitful field. And the work of righteousness shall be peace; and the effect of righteousness, quietness and assurance for ever. And my people shall dwell in a peaceable habitation, and in sure dwellings, and in quiet resting places."

This passage predicts coming judgment and desolation for a period; then, at some future time, the outpouring of God's Spirit; and, as a result, blessing, fruitfulness, justice, righteousness, peace, and quietness for Israel.

Isaiah 44:3

The context of this scripture reads as follows: (44:1-5)

"Yet now hear, O Jacob my servant; and Israel, whom I have chosen. Thus saith the Lord that made thee, and formed thee from the womb, which will help thee; Fear not, O Jacob, my servant; and thou, Jeshurun whom I have chosen. For I will pour water upon him that is thirsty, and floods upon the dry ground: I will pour my Spirit upon thy seed, and my blessing
