- (6) All human beings sinned in their true representative, Adam, and thus deserve the results of sin. God is under no obligation to prevent the results of sin from falling on any human being; if He does, it is a matter of pure grace.
- (7) The atonement of Christ removes all of the results of sin, not at once, but in stages.
- (8) When we suffer from any of the results of sin, we should not ask, "Why is God allowing this to happen to me?" but rather "Why should God prevent this from happening to me?"
