- (2) Should churches associate to establish and maintain hospitals, clinics, hospices, etc.?
- (3) Should churches associate to establish and maintain agencies that work with persons addicted to drugs, alcohol, or gambling, etc.?
- (4) Should churches associate to establish and maintain orphanages?
- (5) Should churches associate to establish and maintain crisis pregnancy centers or pregnancy counseling centers?
- (6) Should churches associate to establish and maintain counseling centers that provide preventive and/or remedial assistance to believers?
- (7) Should churches associate to establish and maintain agencies that work with abused wives or children?
- (8) Should churches associate to establish and maintain agencies that work with prisoners?
- (9) Should churches associate to establish and maintain agencies that work with delinquents, runaways, prostitutes, homosexuals, etc.?
- (10) Should churches associate to establish and maintain Christian educational agencies that prepare believers for various kinds of preventive and/or remedial ministries?
- d. Comparing this area of obligation with other stewardship priorities, and faced with limited resources and virtually unlimited needs, to what extent are Christian churches obligated to attempt to prevent or alleviate suffering in a sinful world?
