

I. A DEFINITION OF HUMAN SUFFERING

A . Scriptural instances of human suffering

Scriptures that contain the word "suffer": (NASB)

NUM 14:33 'And your sons shall be shepherds for forty years in the wilderness, and they shall suffer for your unfaithfulness, until your corpses lie in the wilderness.

NUM 16:29 "If these men die the death of all men, or if they suffer the fate of all men, then the Lord has not sent me.

2CH 21:15 and you will suffer severe sickness, a disease of your bowels, until your bowels come out because of the sickness, day by day. "'

PSA 34:10 The young lions do lack and suffer hunger; But they who seek the Lord shall not be in want of any good thing.

PSA 88:15 I was afflicted and about to die from my youth on; I suffer Thy terrors; I am overcome.

PRO 11:15 He who is surety for a stranger will surely suffer for it, But he who hates going surety is safe.

PRO 13:20 He who walks with wise men will be wise, But the companion of fools will suffer harm.

PRO 19:15 Laziness casts into a deep sleep, And an idle man will suffer hunger.

DAN 6:2 and over them three commissioners (of whom Daniel was one), that these satraps might be accountable to them, and that the king might not suffer loss.

JOE 1:18 How the beasts groan! The herds of cattle wander aimlessly Because there is no pasture for them; Even the flocks of sheep suffer.

MAT 16:21 From that time Jesus Christ began to show His disciples that He must go to Jerusalem, and suffer many things from the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised up on the third day.
